

Regulations of the School Youth Hostel in Świnoujście

Persons who would like to stay at the School Youth Hostel in Świnoujście are asked to abide by the following rules:

§1.

Youth Hostel is for the use of children, school students, students at the age up to 25 years old providing that they abide by the Youth Hostel Regulations.

§2.

The person who would like to make use of the Youth Hostel services should become acquainted with the Youth Hostel Regulations of the check-in and check-out procedures and those concerning setting the due fees at the reception desk.

§3.

Children up to the age of three years old are offered a free stay at our Hostel. Children over the age of 3 must check in.

§4.

No more than three consecutive nights may be spent at our hostel, except when free places are available and the warden will give their permission to stay longer.

§5.

Guests staying in a hostel, are obliged to pick up and put on bed linen.

§6.

The accommodation starts at 5 PM and ends at 10 AM. If You want to stay longer please inform reception one day before end of your stay

§7.

From 22.00 to 6.00 there is a night silence in the hostel with the light off.

§8.

From 10 a.m. to 5 p.m one can stay at the hostel only in case of bad weather conditions or any other circumstances at the warden's permission.

§9.

The common rooms, such as self-service kitchens and tv-rooms are closed at 10 p.m. and opened at 6 a.m.

§10.

There is a strict prohibition of taking into the hostel or drinking alcohol, smoking cigarettes or using drugs.

§11.

In case of breaking down the regulations of the youth hostel or behaving improperly, the warden may request the guest to leave the hostel. In such a case, the warden is also obliged to inform the school or organization concerned about this fact.

§12.

It is possible to pay a guest a short visit from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. in that case you would be asked to show your identity card at the reception desk.

§13.

There is a self-service kitchen in the youth hostel- located downstairs. Our guests are asked to keep it tidy and clean cooking utensils immediately after a meal. At the very day of leaving the guests are asked to put the dirty linen in the laundry bag- situated in a separate room, downstairs, next to the reception office. Also our guests are asked to put rubbish- segregated- into the appropriate containers located next to the gate outside the youth hostel.

§14.

If one spoils or make a serious damage to any object - regarded as the property of the youth hostel - they are asked to report this fact to the warden or a person on duty at the reception desk who could define the conditions of payment.

§15.

Persons who have vehicles should report at reception that they use unguarded SSM parking.

§16.

Groups should book at least one month in advance (it can be done by fax, an e-mail or by post). When booking they should give the surname and the first name of the group leader, his address, the number and sex of the participants, name and address of the school, date and time of the arrival. After the proposed date has been confirmed (it should take place within 10 days) the group leader should immediately send money in advance to the hostel on bank account given by the hostel.
